Official Translation of Documents

All documents issued in a foreign language by the competent authorities of the country of origin, which are to be used in Spain, must be accompanied by an official translation into Spanish.

Article 15.1 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, on the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administrations, establishes that the language of procedures processed by the General State Administration shall be Spanish.

An official translation may be carried out by:

- a) Any Spanish Diplomatic or Consular Representation abroad.

- b) The Diplomatic or Consular Representation in Spain of the applicant's country of citizenship or, where applicable, the country of origin of the document.

- c) A sworn translator duly authorized or registered in Spain.

- d) The Office of Language Interpretation of the Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation.

- e) UNESCO, the Office of the Ibero-American Cooperation Center, or any other organization recognized in Spain.
