

Scholarship Terms and Conditions – Master in Tourism and Sustainable Development

Instituto de Turismo y Desarrollo Económico y Sostenible (TIDES) – ULPGC

1. Purpose

The purpose of these scholarships is to support access to the Master in Tourism and Sustainable Development and to promote applied research and strategic reflection on tourism challenges in the Canary Islands.

2. Beneficiaries

Applicants must be students who have completed the pre-enrolment process for the Master in Tourism and Sustainable Development offered by TIDES at ULPGC.

3. Objective

The scholarships aim to attract talented students and foster the development of future professionals capable of addressing complex challenges in the tourism sector through research, analysis, and innovation.

4. Amount

A total of 6 scholarships will be awarded, each with a duration of 6 months and a total gross amount of €1,500.

The estimated monthly gross amount will be €250. Applicable deductions, including personal income tax and Social Security contributions where required, will be applied in accordance with current regulations at the time of payment.

Beneficiaries will be registered with the Social Security system where applicable.

5. Call and Selection Procedure

Scholarships will be awarded through a competitive selection process based on the submitted documentation.

The final award is conditional upon the applicant's official enrolment in the Master's programme.

6. Application Deadline

Applications must be submitted between **1 September 2026 and 25 September 2026** by email to: tides@ulpgc.es

7. Supporting Documents

Applicants must submit:

- Proof of enrolment in the Master's programme
- Updated CV
- Academic transcript
- Motivation Letter

8. Funded Project and Obligations

Scholarship recipients must carry out a research and applied project for TIDES and the **Federation of Hospitality and Tourism Entrepreneurs (FEHT)**.

The project will address strategic tourism challenges in the Canary Islands, particularly in the province of Las Palmas and Gran Canaria, through joint reflection, research, analysis, and innovation, generating proposals and actionable insights for the sector.

Recipients are required to:

- Actively participate in meetings and working sessions
- Collaborate with TIDES and FEHT representatives.
- Deliver the assigned project within the established timeframe.

Failure to complete and submit the project may result in the obligation to **repay the scholarship funds received**.

9. Payment

Students must first pay the tuition fees. The scholarship amount will be paid in instalments over the duration of the programme.

10. Monitoring and Justification

Beneficiaries must demonstrate satisfactory participation, attendance at meetings, and proper completion of the assigned project. Progress may be monitored throughout the programme.

11. Compatibility and Revocation

The scholarship may be compatible with other financial aid unless otherwise specified. It may be revoked in cases of:

- Failure to meet academic or participation requirements.
- Failure to complete the assigned project
- Withdrawal from the programme

In such cases, beneficiaries may be required to reimburse the amounts received.

12. Dissemination and Publicity

Beneficiaries agree to participate in dissemination and communication activities related to the scholarship programme.

13. Intellectual and Industrial Property

In accordance with the agreement between TIDES and the funding entity, all intellectual and industrial property rights arising from the work carried out by scholarship recipients shall belong exclusively to **FEHT**, including both economic and moral rights where applicable.

FEHT may authorize ULPGC to use the content of such work for internal, academic, and analytical purposes only. Any public dissemination, distribution, or commercial use by ULPGC will require prior express authorization from FEHT, which may revoke such authorization at any time.

Scholarship recipients will be required to formally acknowledge and accept these conditions prior to starting their work.

14. Confidentiality and Data Protection

In compliance with **Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation)** and **Organic Law 3/2018**, each participating entity shall act as data controller for the personal data processed within the framework of this programme.

Personal data will be processed solely for the purpose of managing and executing the scholarship and will be retained as long as necessary, unless legal obligations require otherwise. Data will not be shared with third parties except where legally required or necessary for programme execution.

Data subjects may exercise their rights of access, rectification, erasure, objection, restriction of processing, data portability, and the right to lodge a complaint with the relevant supervisory authority, in accordance with applicable regulations.

15. Acceptance of Terms

Submission of an application implies full acceptance of these terms and conditions.

16. Applicable Law

These terms shall be governed by applicable Spanish legislation.
